Subsidy of Camp Promotion Project for National Teams

No charge within the limit amount of subsidy.

Per team City: 2 million yen

By applying for Okayama Prefecture's subsidy system, there is no need to pay within a limit amount of subsidy.

Requirements

Camp shall be for National Team or representative players

Sports facilities and accommodation in Okayama City shall be used

Activities with local people shall be carried out

Camp shall be promoted by Okayama Sports Association (※ Olympic Games)

Example National Team from overseas stays in Okayama City for 7days and 6 nights.

Transportation Fee (domestic)	$30,000 \text{ yen} \times 30 \text{ people} = 900,000 \text{ yen}$
Accommodation Fee	$15,000 \text{ yen} \times 30 \text{ people} \times 6 \text{ days} = 2.7 \text{ million yen}$
Operation Fee	1 million yen
Total	4.6 million yen



Subsidy rate 1/2
Total 4.6 million yen / 2 = 2.3 million yen

Subsidy limit amount of 2 million yen is provided from Okayama City

Same amount is offered from Okayama Prefecture by making another application.
