




### Map of Kitakyushu

# Kokura One of the most popular tourist destinations in Fukuoka



- The only existing castle tower in Fukuoka Prefecture
- Originally built in 1602 (castle tower reconstructed in 1959)
- Open until 8 pm (7 pm from November to March)
- Wide variety of fun exhibits inside
- Unique Venue available at the top of the castle tower after evening

- The garden features reconstructed Edo period samurai residence and feudal lord's garden
- Shiro Terrace houses a souvenir shop, a Japanese café, and rest space
- Japanese tea ceremonies, kimonos, and rickshaws are available around the castle

# **Mojiko** One of the most popular tourist destinations in Fukuoka

#### **Historic Buildings**



- Mojiko had prospered as an international trading port since the late 19th century and has become one of the leading tourist spots in Fukuoka prefecture
- Historic city walk along the strait including Mojiko Station, the symbol of Mojiko, and the Former Moji Mitsui Club is recommended
- You should also try local specialties such as baked curry, pufferfish, and craft beer

# **Night View**

**One of "Japan's New Three Most Spectacular Night Views"** 

#### Mt. Sarakura



- Mt. Sarakura is a symbol of the city which ranked number one in "Japan's New Three Most Spectacular Night Views"
- After riding a cable car and a slope car to the top you can enjoy a panoramic city view of over 200 degrees

#### Numerous night viewing spots



- Wakato Bridge was built in 1962 and was the forerunner of Japan's long suspension bridges
- The top of Mt. Takato offers magnificent views of the gigantic Wakato Bridge and the city
- Factory night view cruise tour is available every weekend (chartered cruises also available)
- Mekari Park located in Mojiko is the best spot to view the Kanmon Strait and the Kanmon Bridge
- Kokura Illumination is held from November to January every year in central Kokura

- Designated as a national natural monument
- You can enjoy trekking, caving, and trail running, as well as beautiful seasonal landscapes
- Chosen as one of "Japan's 31 Most Beautiful Places" by America's CNN

## Festivals



#### **Summer festivals**



- Tobata Gion Festival: Famous for its towering "pyramids of light" / UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage
- Kokura Gion Festival: Performances with taiko drums / Important Intangible Folk Cultural Property of Japan
- Wasshoi Hyakuman Summer Festival: Kitakyushu's largest festival, including fireworks, stalls, and events where floats and portable shrines participate from throughout the city

### Gourmet





- Surrounded by water on three sides, Kitakyushu serves a wide selection of seafood
- Especially sushi from Kitakyushu is famous throughout Japan
- Other dishes like Fugu and Kokura beef are also very famous dishes from the area

### Kaku-uchi (Drinking at Liquor Stores)



- What is a kaku-uchi? It is a liquor store where you can drink and chat with the owner and other locals.
- There are about 100 kaku-uchi places you can enjoy in Kitakyushu!

- There are many hotels with parking space for large scale buses
- "Sui Sui" is a Japanese style inn with a 100 year-old garden, perfect for FITs
